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

MAPA: Structure





DIPOV: responsibilities

- ✓ Main objective: promoting and coordinating the activities of plant inspection throughout Brazil
- ✓ Aims to ensure the *quality, hygiene and health* of the plant products and sub products intended for consumers



CGQV/DIPOV: offical competence

- ✓ Regulation of the activities related to classification and grading, standardization, audit and quality, hygienic-sanitary and technological inspection of vegetal origin products;
- ✓ Participation in activities related to negotiation of national and international agreements, treaties, protocols or agreements, concerning subjects related to vegetal origin products inspection: Mercosul, Unece, Codex Alimentarius
- ✓ Coordination and evaluation of *techinical-fiscal and operational audits* of activities related to the inspection of vegetal origin products;
- ✓ Coordination of the *National Control Plan Residues and Contaminants in Plant Products* PNCRC/Vegetal.







- Publishing horizontal inspection model based on a simplified general standard for fresh fruits and vegetables;
- Enabling application of a methodology of risk analysis in inspection and official controls of establishments and plant origin products;
- Training of the agents involved: Producers, inspectors, managers, traders.
