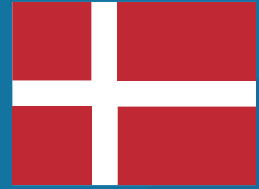

Mauro Mendes

Governor of the Mato Grosso State, Mauro Mendes is 55 years old, born in Anápolis, Goiás. He studied at the Federal University of Mato Grosso and graduated in Electrical Engineering. He is an entrepreneur in steel structures, mining, energy and public concessions. Mauro Mendes chaired the Federation of Industries of the State of Mato Grosso (FIEMT) and the Industry's Social Service (SESI), as well as National Service of Industrial Learning (Senai). Governor of Mato Grosso since 2019, he was formerly mayor of the Capital city, Cuiaba, from 2013-2016.

Senator Irajá Silvestre Filho

Senator Irajá is the youngest senator elected in Brazil. He is the First Secretary of the Federal Senate and member of the Parliamentary Interparty Group on Agriculture and Livestock (FPA). Prior to his mandate in the Senate, he chaired, in 2015, the Agriculture Committee in the House of Representatives.



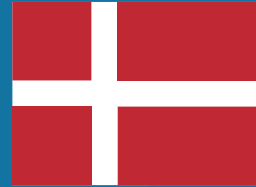
Fernando Camargo

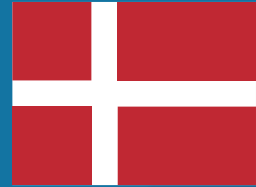
Claus Saabye Erichsen

Flemming Nør-Pedersen

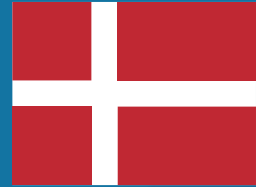

Lisbeth Henricksen

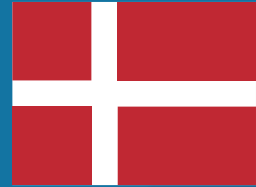

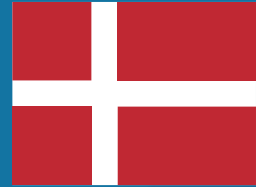
Rodrigo Lima

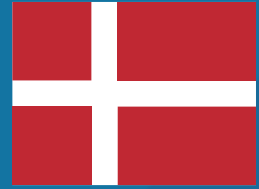
Wellington Andrade
