(a) In 41 municipalities that make up the banks of the Amazon River, all cattle and buffaloes are vaccinated in the periods from March 15th to April 30th and cattle and buffaloes up to 24 months from July 15th to August 30th. In the municipalities of Barcelos, Carauari, Novo Airão, Juruá, São Gabriel da Cachoeira, Tapauá, Presidente Figueiredo and Santa Isabel do Rio Negro all cattle and buffalo are vaccinated in the month of May, and the cattle and buffalo aged up to 24 months are vaccinated in the month of November.

(b) In the Pantanal area, vaccination is carried out in all bovine and buffalo herds in the period from November 1st to December 15th.

(c) In the Pantanal area, the farmers must vaccinate the entire herd, choosing between May 1st to June 15th, or November 1st to December 15th.

(d) In the municipalities of Faro and Terra Santa, all cattle and buffalo are vaccinated in the period from March 15th to April 30th, and cattle and buffalo aged up to 24 months in the period from July 15th to August 30th. In the municipality of Juruti (properties located on the left bank of the Juruti Velho River) all cattle and buffalo are vaccinated in the months of May and November. In the Marajó Archipelago, the bovine and buffalo herds are vaccinated from August 15th to October 15th.

(e) Vaccination in the indian reserve "Raposa Serra do Sol" and "São Marcos" occurs until May 15th and November 15th.

(f) In Bananal Island, all cattle and buffaloes are vaccinated in the period from August 1st to September 15th
