Section I – GENERAL INFORMATION

a) **This list can be found on the website** of the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock (MAPA), at www.gov.br/agricultura/pt-br/viajantes and **may be updated at any time** as a result of sanitary events, updates on sanitary or phytosanitary risk management, as well as changes in customs procedures.

b) Upon arrival in Brazil:



1. The traveller who is transporting **agricultural goods of PROHIBITED entry** must **VOLUNTARILY DISPOSE PROHIBITED agricultural products and inputs** in the appropriate agricultural containers (if available at the point of entry) before going to customs control **or** must **DECLARE** them (via the procedure for declaring the traveller's assets established by customs control) and present to the International Agricultural Surveillance (VIGIAGRO), through customs control in the "Goods to Declare" channel.



2. The traveller who is transporting **agricultural goods with REQUIREMENTS for entry** must **DECLARE** that them (via the procedure for declaring the traveller's goods established by customs control) and present to the International Agricultural Surveillance (VIGIAGRO), through customs control in the "Goods to Declare" channel.



3. The traveller who is transporting **agricultural goods of ALLOWED entry** **does not need to declare** them for the purposes of the Federal Agricultural Inspection.

Attention: the traveller who is transporting **agricultural goods of ALLOWED entry** in **quantities above those authorized** as baggage by the Federal Revenue of Brazil must **DECLARE** them and present to **the Federal Revenue of Brazil**, through customs control in the "Goods to Declare" channel.

Attention: For the traveller who is in **doubt about the correct classification** of one's agricultural goods, it is advised **to DECLARE** them and present to the International Agricultural Surveillance (VIGIAGRO), through customs control in the "Goods to Declare" channel.



4. The traveller who has **visited agricultural production or exhibition areas in the last 15 days** must **DECLARE** this information (via the traveller's goods declaration procedure established by customs control) and present to the International Agricultural Surveillance (VIGIAGRO), through customs control in the "Goods to Declare" channel.
5. In places where the "Goods to Declare" channel does not exist, the traveller must go directly to the customs inspection.
- c) Failure **to comply with a mandatory procedure for the traveller**, the transport **of agricultural goods of PROHIBITED entry**, as well as the transport of **agricultural goods that DO NOT meet all the pre-established requirements for their regular entry**, as described in this list, may charge the traveller to legal penalties provided in article 27 of Law No. 14,515, of December 29, 2022.
- d) **Transport vehicles, travellers and their luggage** that enter the national territory **are subject to selection** for the purposes of agricultural inspection, based on agricultural risk management criteria established by MAPA.
- e) Agricultural **goods seized and those voluntarily discarded** by travellers will be subjected to **treatment and destination approved by MAPA** to mitigate sanitary and phytosanitary risks.
- f) Without prejudice to the regulation established by MAPA Ordinance No. 872, of 12/12/2025, the agricultural assets included in this list are subject to **control rules and procedures established by other agencies**, such as the establishment of **maximum quantities authorized** for their transport as traveller's baggage
