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




Impacts, Mitigation and Lessons Learned



Supply/demand imbalance hibernated 77 installations offshore Brazil in 2020. <u>6 units halted operations due to COVID-19 outbreaks</u>;



Safety barriers failures led to **hyperlocal outbreaks**;



Prevention (quarantine, pre-boarding testing, POB reduction) and **mitigation** (masks, ventilation) measures are **essential**;



POB reduction effective: $64\%_{min}$ - $74\%_{ytd}$;



COLLABORATIONRegulatory Framework Review





Limited obligations during the contingency caused by COVID-19. Focus on Contingency Plans, Safe POB Reduction & Safety Critical Elements (SCEs).

ADAPTATION ANP's Remote Regulatory Audits



Verify: (i) **POB** adequacy to the minimum operational workforce; (ii) SCEs mandatory tests; (iii) **MoC**: management of temporary absences and replacements; (iv) **Maintenance** issues and nonconformities from former SCEs' inspections.
