

## **NORMATIVE INSTRUCTION No. 448 OF 1 JUNE 2026**

Amends Normative Instruction IN no. 389 of 29 July 2025, which provides for the temporary health measures to be adopted by ports and airports considering the current epidemiological scenario, pursuant to Articles 12 and 19 of Collegiate Board Resolution – RDC No. 932/2024.

The Collegiate Board of Directors of the Brazilian Health Regulatory Agency, in the use of the attributions vested in it under Article 7, item III, and Article 15, items III and IV of Law no. 9,782 of 26 January 1999, and Article 187, item VII, Paragraph 1 of the Internal Regulation approved by Collegiate Board Resolution – RDC No. 585 of 10 December 2021, adopts the following Normative Instruction, as decided upon in a meeting held on 27 May 2026, and I, Director-President, determine its publication.

Article 1. This Normative Instruction amends Normative Instruction IN No. 389 of 29 July 2025, published in the Federal Official Gazette No. 143 of 31 July 2025, section 1, page 82, which provides for temporary health measures to be adopted by ports and airports considering the current epidemiological scenario, pursuant to Articles 12 and 19 of Collegiate Board Resolution – RDC No. 932/2024.

Article 2. The Annex to Normative Instruction IN No. 389 of 29 July 2025 shall be amended as set forth in the Annex to this Normative Instruction, due to the declaration of a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) related to the Ebola disease caused by the Bundibugyo virus.

Article 3. This Normative Instruction shall enter into force on the date of its publication.
