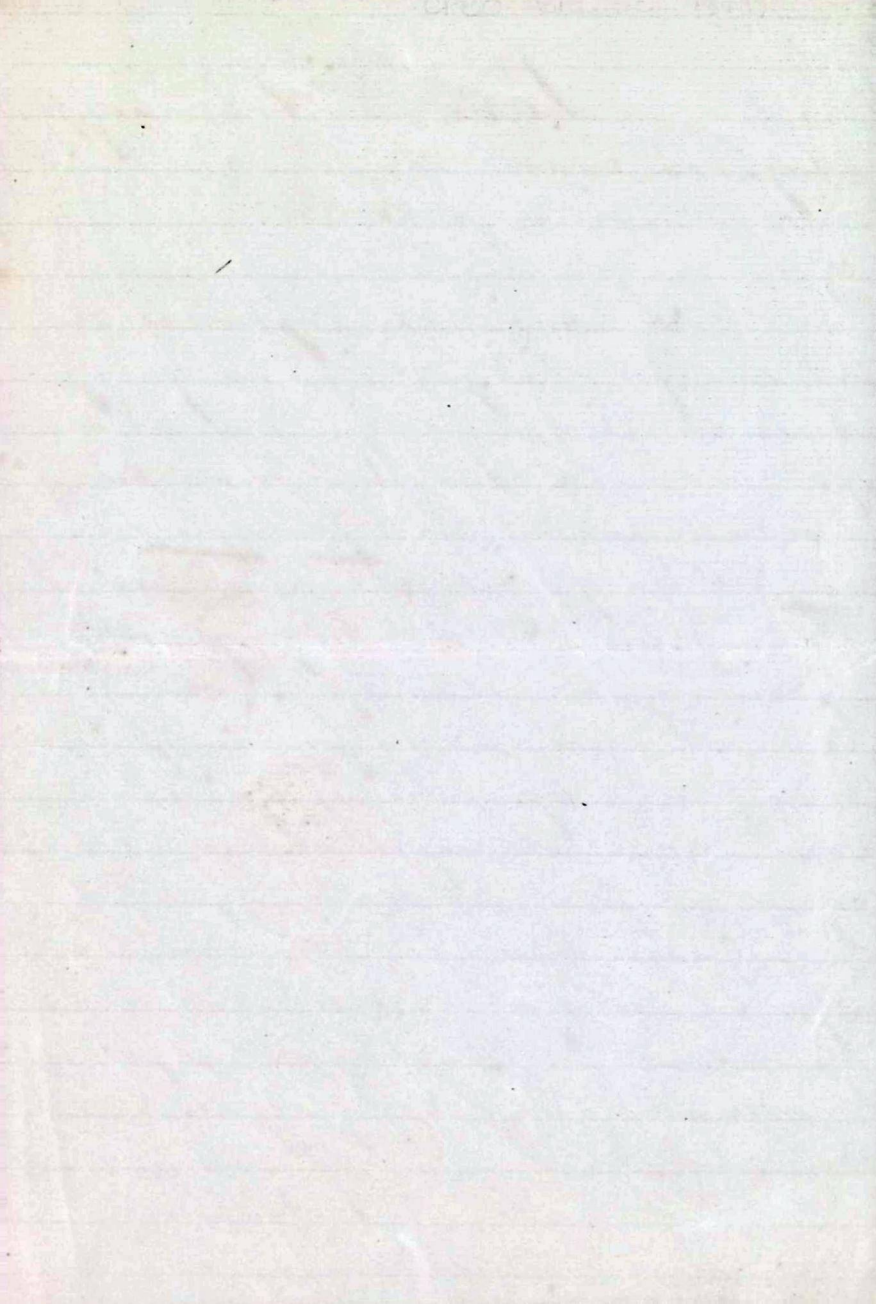


Paris 22^m February 90
