Minha muito querida Mercedes

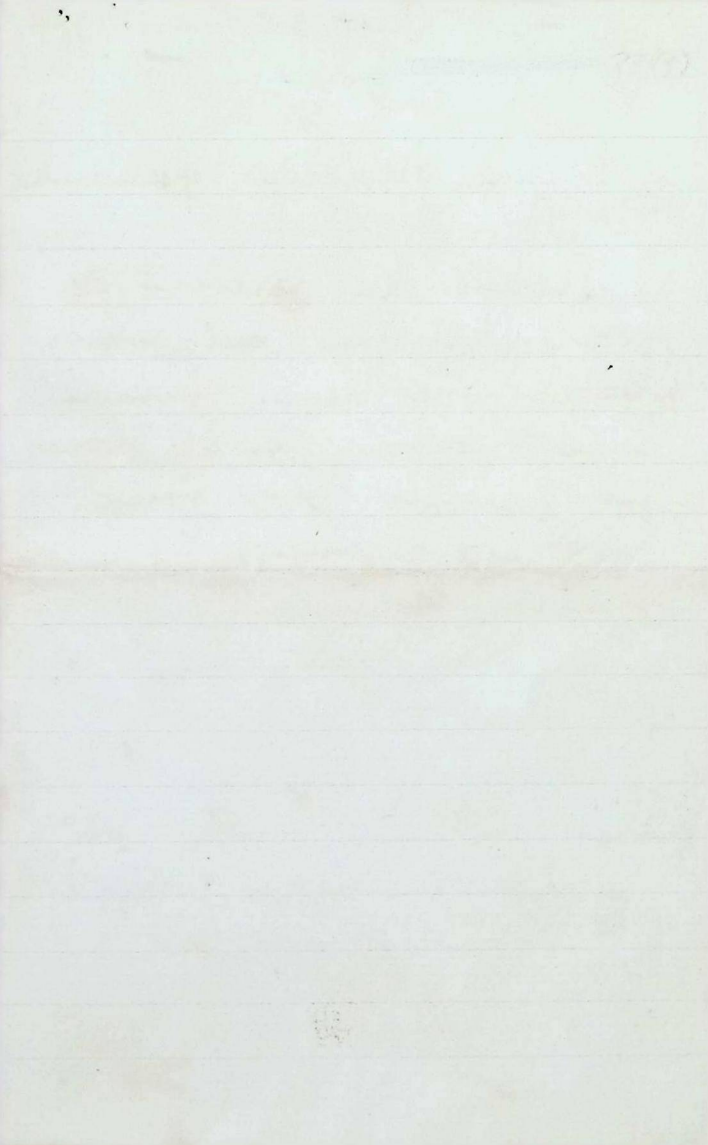
Desejava saber como
