

SHIPPED, by the Grace of God, in good Order and well-conditioned, by *Bradshaw Wanklyn King*

in and upon the good Ship called the *Globe*
whereof is Master, under God, for this present Voyage, *R. Johnson*
and now riding at Anchor in the *Port of Rio de Janeiro* and by God's Grace, bound for
Hamburg to say

B. 1900 Bags

*One thousand nine Hundred Bags containing
nine thousand five Hundred arrobas of Coffee*

being marked and numbered as in the Margin, and are to be delivered in the like good Order and well-conditioned, at the aforesaid Port of *Hamburg* (The Act of God, the King's Enemies, Fire, and all and every other Dangers and Accidents of the Seas, Rivers, and Navigation, of whatever Nature and Kind soever excepted) unto *Messrs. Bucker & Co.*

or to their Assigns, he or they paying Freight for the said Goods *Fifty Shillings Sterling*
per Ton nett weight, with Five percent.
with Primage and Average accustomed. In Witness whereof I, the said Master or Purser of the said Ship
hath affirmed to *you* Bills of Lading, all of this Tenor and Date; the one of which *from* Bills
being accomplished, the other *shall* stand void. And so God send the good Ship to her desired
Port in Safety. Amen. Dated in *Rio de Janeiro 27 July 1825*
