the Ton of Twenty Hundred weight with five Pence
with Primage and Average accustomed by writress whereof the Master or
Purser of the said Ship hath affirmed to *four* Bills of Lading, all of this Ten
norand Date the one of which *four* Bills being accomplished, the other *three*
