

RIO DE JANEIRO. 11<sup>th</sup> March 1834

**CHARTER-PARTY.**

It is this Day mutually agreed between *N. E. Frook, Master*  
of the good Ship or Vessel, called the *Charlotte Maria* of the Measurement of  
*One hundred & Fifty Two* Tons, or thereabouts, now at Anchor in the Port of *Rio de Janr.* and  
*Messrs Bradshaw Franklyn & Sons of this City Merchants*  
That the said Ship being tight, staunch, and strong, and everyway fitted for the Voyage, shall, with all convenient Speed  
Receive in this port a full and complete Cargo  
of Coffee in Bags.

not exceeding what she can reasonably stow and carry, over and above her Tackle, Apparel, Provisions, and Furniture; and, being so loaded, shall  
therewith proceed to

*the port of Loures for Orders and from thence*  
*either to Santos, Antwerp or Intermediate port or London*  
*or to Trieste.*

or so near thereunto as she may safely get, and deliver the same on being paid Freight

*at the rate of Two*

*Pounds Stg. p. Ton nett weight and five p. Cent*

*Primage if to any of the abovementioned ports except*  
*Trieste and if to said port then Twenty five shilling*  
*Stg. p. Ton nett weight additional freight to be paid*  
*and five p. Cent primage.*

*The Vessel to be consigned to the Charterers Agents at*  
*the port of delivery.*

(the Act of God the King's Enemies, Fire, and all and every other Dangers and Accidents of the Seas, Rivers, and Navigation, of watherer nature  
and kind soever during the said Voyage always excepted.)

The Freight to be paid on unloading, and right delivery of the Cargo *at the port of Delivery*

*Twenty five* Running Days are to be allowed the said *Charterers* (if the Ship is not sooner dispatched) for  
*discharging the Cargo, and detention at Loures. The Cargo*  
*to be shipped here without Delay, But the Vessel to*  
*remain in port untill a good opportunity for*  
*sending Insurance.*

Days on Demurrage, over and above the said laying Days, at

*Four pounds Stg. p. Day*
