Dear Mr. Lobenhoffer

Just a few lines to forward you a booklet with the interview with General Rebello, the commander of one "corp d'armée" who have beaten the rebels of São Paulo; it is in every respect a trustworthy report which I consider very reliable.

You will see how the rebels only initiated this rebellion to put in power the professional politicians who caused so much harin and were not very honest.

Mr. Murray is leaving England on the 5 Instant, and I hope that now will see business take a more active and profitable turnover between us.

As regards the next crop, the reports I have and are reliable; that in São Paulo the blossom is excellent in Minas and Rio de Janeiro, and all point to a good size crop, Victoria I hear will give 1,450,000 Bags.
