THE PERU NATIONAL CODIFICATION BUREAU

1. AIM

- Manage the Defense Codification System of Peru in accordance with the NATO Codification System (NCS) based on the rules and regulations established by AC/135.
- Provide facilities and support codification activities at national and international level.
- Identify and code supply items produced by Peruvian manufacturers and used by military services and NATO countries or NATO-sponsored countries.
- Support the development of the Peruvian defense industry.
- Support the logistical efficiency of the Peruvian Defense Sector.

2. ORGANIZATION

The NCB - Peru is responsible for the codification policy of Peru and for the coordination of all codification activities for the armed forces and other organizations.

Organizationally, the NCB - Peru is part of the Procurement Agency of the Armed Forces of Peru, under the Codification Department. The NCB of Peru is organized into three tiers:

-Third Step: Formed by the NCB - Peru, the governing unit and therefore the highest technical authority of the NATO codification process of supply goods of the Defense Sector of Peru.


-Second Step: Formed by the codification centers of the Joint Command of the Armed Forces (CCFFAA) and of the Armed Institutions, located within the organization of their Command or Logistics Department; in charge of the centralized technical direction of the NCS in their respective Institution and of complying with the provisions of the NCB - Peru.

-First Step: Formed by the codification sub-centers of the Armed Institutions, in charge of the NATO codification of supply goods of the Defense Sector of Peru (identification, classification, denomination and codification) and of complying with the provisions of the NCB - Peru and the respective codification center.


Currently, Peru's NCB is led by the Director of Codification of the Armed Forces Procurement Agency.

3. HISTORY

November 2012

On November 14, 2012, the Peruvian Ministry of Defense and AC/135 signed the Sponsorship Agreement through which Peru joins Tier 1 of the NCS, and allows Peru to use the NATO Codification System for the management and exchange of information related to the supply of military material and equipment.

September 2015

The Minister of Defense appoints the Head of the Armed Forces Procurement Agency and the Director of Codification of the Armed Forces Procurement Agency as the Titular and Alternate Representative, respectively, of the Defense Sector before the NATO Allied Committee AC/135; and designates the Codification Department as the National Codification Bureau of Peru, and responsible for the implementation, administration and operation of the NATO Codification System in the Defense Sector of Peru.

December 2019

The Codification Tool for Defense – SICAD, developed by the Ministry of Defense of Spain, was installed and put into operation at the Peruvian Armed Forces Purchasing Agency.

January 2020

Peru begins codification military items from the Defense Sector, through the Codification Tool for Defense – SICAD, using the NMCRL WEB and the NATO Mailbox (NMBS).

4. CODIFICATION TOOL OF THE NCB – PERÚ

For the codification of all supply items used by the Armed Forces uses the codification tool – SICAD, developed by the Spanish Ministry of Defense, in accordance with the rules of the NATO codification System.

Peru's codification tool is based on a three-tier architecture that uses a database server, an application server, and client workstations. SICAD's work platform is Oracle. - communication between servers and workstations via LAN.

The Peruvian codification tool meets the requirements established in ACodP-1, ACodP-2 – Guide to groups and classes, ACodP-3 – Guide to article names, CodSP – codification support publications, FIIG – Federal guide to article identification

The codification Tool supports the following functions:

- Classification and identification of items using all 7 types of item identification (reference and descriptive) and issuing a stock number,
- Modification of codified items,
- Cancellation of codified items,
- Reinstatement of canceled items,
- Issuing NCAGE numbers and maintenance of manufacturers/suppliers data,
- Management of requests for codification Screening,
- Screening of groups and classes,
- Screening approved item names,
- Screening NCAGE,
- Screening items by codes,
- Screening items by characteristics International operations,
- Maintaining AC135 forms,
- Generation of international requests (according ACodP-1 rules),
- Processing international requests,
- Generating transactions,
- Processing transactions,
- Automatic generation of periodic reports to NSPA,
- Automatic generation of System Support Records (SSR) to NSPA Communication,
- Transaction export to NMBS,
- Transaction import from NMBS Administration,
- Maintaining users' data and access rights,
- Maintaining basic tables data from ACodP-1, ACodP-2, ACodP-3, CodSP etc.



5. STANAGS

- STANAG 3150 - ACFFAA- "Uniform System of Supply Classification"

The NCB of Peru uses the following types of data::

- Identification Data,
- User Data,
- Reference Data,
- Clear Text Characteristics Data,
- Coded Characteristics Data,
- Manufacturers Data.

7. TELETRANSMISSION:

For codification data exchange, Peru uses the NATO Mailbox System.
