

# NATIONAL CODIFICATION BUREAU OF THE SLOVAK REPUBLIC

## 1. ORGANISATION

The Slovak NCB is an integral part of Defence Standardization, Codification and Government Quality Assurance Authority ("DSCGQA Authority"). At the Slovak NCB work 5 employees – all civilians. Slovak NCB is located in the city Trenčín. A distance from the capital city of the Slovak republic - Bratislava is 130 km.



## 2. AIM

- To manage national Codification System in conformity with the NATO Codification System based on rules, regulations and procedures set down in AC/135.
- To provide and support the codification activities on the national and international level.
- To support Users of MCC WEB powered by MC Catalogue.
- To support Slovak Military Industry.
- To support Slovak Armed Forces.
- To provide training of the subjects participating in codification processes (industry, acquisition, authorities, logistics, end users, codifiers).
- To develop and provide national handbooks and national tools for codification.
- To maintain and update Total Item Record and System Support Record for each codified item of supply.
- To constantly improve the data quality of MCC WEB.

### 3. HISTORY OF THE SLOVAK CODIFICATION ACTIVITIES

2004	<p>Governmental law 11/2004 - Defence Standardization, Codification and Governmental Quality Assurance became valid.</p> <p>Establishment of the Codification department of the Defence Standardization, Codification and Governmental Quality Assurance Authority.</p> <p>The Slovak Republic ratified Standardization Agreements STANAG 3150, 3151, 4177, 4199, 4438.</p> <p>MC Catalogue is fully capable to perform codification tasks.</p>
2005	<p>Upgrade of codification tool MC CATALOGUE to environment J2EE.</p> <p>Slovak NCB issued first edition of Slovak national codification database SK-kod.</p>
2007	<p>New organization structure – Creation two sections of the Slovak NCB. First section is responsible for international cooperation and second section carry out codification work.</p>
2009	<p>New organization structure – reduction employees, first and second section of the codification department were merge.</p>
2010	<p>New organization structure – reduction employees.</p>
2019	<p>Start of the new MCC WEB powered by MC CATALOGUE in the Government CLOUD of Ministry of Interior of the Slovak Republic to fulfil AC/135 demands for codification based on NATO Data Exchange Redesign (NDER) Project.</p>
2021	<p>NDER Compliance Tests under the management of NSPA.</p>
2022	<p>Launching of MCC WEB with NDER implementation.</p>

## 4. CODIFICATION TOOL – MCC WEB

The MCC WEB powered by MC CATALOGUE is the codification system used by Slovak NCB for the codification of all items of supply according to the rules of the NATO Codification System. The MCC WEB is operated in the Internet environment. MCC WEB is constantly improved by new functionalities. Software tool is a product of AURA Ltd., Brno, Czech Republic.

The Slovak NCB is a member of MC CATALOGUE User Group to coordinate steps and users demands for development of MC CATALOGUE SW.

### Basic characteristics

- widely available information system;
- application with controlled user access;
- servers under government security administration;
- direct access for military, industry and codification agencies;
- automated database update (SSR - System Support Records);
- allows direct connection to AC135 servers for information exchange.

- Operational system: CentOS 7 Linux
- Database system: PostgreSQL
- Development environment: JAVA
- Communication protocols: TCP/IP
- MCC WEB version: 6.01.2702

## 5. CODIFICATION TRAINING

NCB SVK coordinates two kinds of tailored trainings:

- The 3-day training on codification rules and procedures for Slovak producers and vendors.
- The 1-day training on codification rules and procedures for commercial codification agencies two times per year.
- The 3-day training on codification rules and procedures for logisticians of Armed forces of the Slovak republic.
