The Moroccan National Codification Bureau (MOR NCB)

1. AIM

The MOR NCB is the only organization in Morocco authorized to codify items of supply and to coordinate all the activities concerning the identification, classification and codification of articles in accordance to the rules of the NATO codification system.

The MOR NCB belongs to the 4th Bureau of the Royal Armed forces.

Its main goals are:

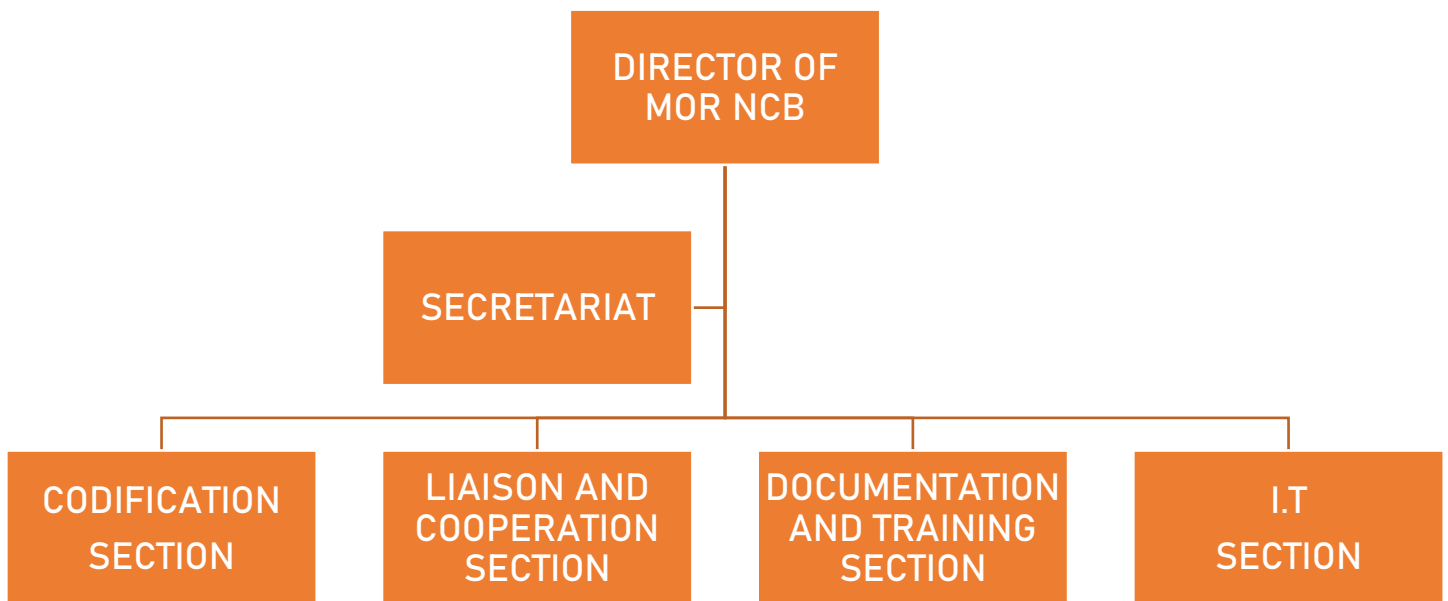
- ✓ Identification and codification of items of supply used by Royal Armed Forces;
- ✓ Maintenance of a Total Item Record (TIR) that holds identification data for each item of supply which has been codified;
- ✓ Act as unique and mandatory point of contact for all international data exchange.
- ✓ Develop and distribute national cataloguing publications and organize training sessions on codification for personnel of the Morocco Armed Forces and Defence suppliers.

2. HISTORY

- 2005 :** Royal Instruction to launch the Royal Armed Forces membership project in the NCS, and its adoption by the 4th Bureau.
- 2006 :** Submission of Morocco's official request to AC/135 for NCS sponsorship.
- 2007 :** -Unanimous approval by NCS members of Morocco's application.
-TIER 1 Agreement signed between Royal Armed Forces and AC/135.
-Creation of the Equipment Codification Center of the Royal Armed Forces.
- 2012 :** Establishment of Morocco's official request to become Tier 2 sponsored nation, and start of compliance tests.
- 2012 :** Morocco hosted the 102nd Main Group Meeting in Marrakech.

2014 : TIER 2 sponsorship Certificate signed between Royal Armed Forces of Morocco and AC/135.
Morocco was the first African nation to reach this stage of the NCS sponsorship.
