

## The Caribbean concentrate most of natural disasters at their highest intensity


- Some are seasonal - Hurricane
- Some are predictable - Hurricane, volcanos
- Some are unpredictable - Earthquake, tsunami





## 2 lines of operations divided in 7 phases

- Recce teams => assessment and network set up



- APOD and/or SPOD safe and useful






- Set up theatre supply chain
