

Decisions of the Madrid Protocol

The new decisions of the Gazette *Revista da Propriedade Industrial* – RPI of the Brazilian National Institute of Industrial Property – INPI acting as **Office of Origin** in the Madrid Protocol are:

- Notice of inconsistencies related to payment;
- Notice of inconsistencies;
- Decision to consider an international application as non-existent due to lack of payment;
- Decision to consider an international application as non-existent due to non-remedied payment inconsistency;
- Decision to consider an international application as non-existent due to non-responded payment inconsistency;
- Decision to consider an international application as non-existent due to a non-responded notice of inconsistencies;
- Decision to consider an international application as non-existent due to failure to meet the certification requirements;
- International application certified and submitted to the International Bureau;
- Notice of nonconformity sent by the International Bureau;
- Response about nonconformity sent to the International Bureau;
- *Petição de correção de dados em pedido internacional* (Petition for the correction of data in an international application) (3010) granted;
- *Petição de correção de dados em pedido internacional* (Petition for the correction of data in an international application) (3010) rejected.

For the **designations received by Brazil** from other contracting parties through the Madrid Protocol, the same decisions which are already in use for national applications shall apply.
