

**LETTER OF INTENT BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF POSTS OF MINISTRY OF
COMMUNICATIONS OF INDIA
AND THE
MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS OF BRAZIL**

The Department of Posts, Ministry of Communications, Government of India and the Ministry of Communications of Brazil, referred to hereinafter as “The Parties”

- Being Governmental authorities and recognizing the vital role that postal services play in enhancing communication, trade and socio-economic development;
- Acknowledging the mutual benefits that can be derived from bilateral cooperation in postal services, logistics and supply chain integration, technology sharing, capacity building and e-commerce;
- Affirming the shared commitment to promote South-South Cooperation as a means of fostering inclusive growth, knowledge exchange and technological advancement.

The Parties have reached the following intent:

- Facilitate cooperation that would enable synergy in sharing experiences and know-how as per the extant regulations of each country;
- Promote and enhance cooperation at multi-lateral fora involving Postal Operations, with a view to working for the common interests of both parties;
- Enter into a future Memorandum of Understanding that provides for enhanced cooperation, including the exchange of information subject to confidentiality guarantees on postal sector policies and regulations, market

development initiatives, joint training activities, and provisions regarding its duration.

The above objectives may be achieved by a Consultative Mechanism involving both the Parties and comprising functionaries as decided by each side. The Parties shall provide all assistance and cooperation in furthering the spirit of this Letter of Intent.

This Letter of Intent enters into force on the date of its signature.
