The Brazilian NCP is an Interministerial Working Group and, until the end of 2022, was linked to the Ministry of Economy. It was composed of representatives of the following bodies and entities: I - two from the Ministry of Economy, of which: a) one from the Special Secretariat for Foreign Trade and International Affairs, which coordinated it; and b) one from the Special Secretariat for Productivity and Competitiveness; II - one from the Attorney General's Office; III - one from the 'Central Bank of Brazil'; IV - one of the Comptroller General' of the Union; V - one from the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Supply; VI - one from the Ministry of Justice and Public Security; VII - one from the Ministry of the Environment; VIII - one from the Ministry of Mines and Energy; IX - one from the Ministry of Women, Family and Human Rights; X - one from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; and XI - one of the Ministry of Labor and Social Security. The NCP is responsible for: I - to disseminate the OECD (Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development) Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises and resolve doubts about their implementation; II - to act as a non-judicial mechanism for resolving disputes between individuals or legal entities governed by private law in allegations of non-compliance with the OECD (Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development) Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises; III - to coordinate and ensure the coherence of responsible business conduct policies; and IV - to follow the OECD (Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development) discussions on the implementation of the OECD (Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development) Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises and complementary negotiations.
