The Brazilian NCP works towards policy coherence through: - the action plans on RBC and business and human rights; - its own inter-agency working group, which includes relevant public bodies related to the OECD Guidelines' themes and key sectors; - the supervision by the National Investment Committee of the Board of Foreign Trade and Investment of the Ministry of Economy; - partnership with other strategic public bodies/agencies in Brazil, as the Executive Office of the President and the Securities and Exchange Commission.

In 2022, there are two action plans being developed: 1 – on RBC, by the Ministry of Economy; 2 – on Business and Human Rights, by the Ministry of Women, Family and Human Rights. The NCP is providing support to both of them. The RBC Action Plan was concluded and published in the end of 2022.
