### Introduction (1)

#### Rationale

- Development of a coherent and realistic plan
  - Careful selection of a balanced set of instruments and tools, enabling further strengthening of the infrastructures
- Successful implementation and enforcement and building synergies and complementarities between components
  - Clarification of the technical details of the proposed developments
- Convincing decision makers to invest in SMC
  - Adequate formulation of the proposals, including specific legal text

### Key steps

- Select Policy Solutions
- Define a Phased Approach
- Draft Legislative Proposals
- Draft Institutional Proposals
- Design Cost Recovery Measures

### **Objectives and Expected Outputs**

### Objectives

- Define a coherent approach for strengthening legal and institutional infrastructures for SMC
- Develop technical proposals for the priority activities
- Devise a set of interventions to be conducted for implementation of the priority developments

### Expected Outputs

- A summary of the phased approach for strengthening LIIs
- Technical proposals for the priority actions
- An action plan for implementing the priority developments

### **Selection of Policy Solutions (1)**

- Coherent package of measures
  - Legal, institutional, and financing developments as a whole
  - Think about possible:
    - Synergies
    - Opportunities for cooperation
    - Resources sharing
- Balanced mix of instruments
  - Regulatory/ non-regulatory
  - Compliance promotion
- Possible prioritization

### Definition of a Phased Approach (1)

#### Phases

- Long term approach for strengthening SMC legal and institutional infrastructures
  - Description
  - Goal
  - Key principles and elements
- Short term action plan for proposed priority package of measures
  - Objectives and indicators
  - Activities and tasks
  - Schedule
  - Budget

### Drafting Legislative Proposals (1)

### Main components

- Reorganization of the legal framework (laws)
- Consolidation VS Harmonization
- Development of regulations/ rules of procedure
  - Filling regulatory gaps
- Amendment of related sectoral legislation
  - Often needed for increased integration of chemicals management into national development policy

### Drafting Legislative Proposals (2)

#### Key elements

- Domestication of international/regional agreements
- Scope and definitions
- Powers and mandates, roles and responsibilities
- Mandates for coordination and cooperation
- Instruments and tools
- Inspection requirements
- Record keeping and reporting
- Offences and sanctions
- Confidentiality of information
- Appeals

### **Drafting Institutional Proposals (1)**

- Main considerations for the development of institutional proposals
  - Organization of administration at the three levels
  - Reform of existing bodies VS Creation of new bodies
  - Coordination and cooperation mechanisms
    - Internal and external
  - Information management system
    - Including monitoring and surveillance
  - Human and technical capacity
    - Sharing and capacity building

### **Designing Cost Recovery Measures (1)**

- Key design elements
- Supporting public service(s)
- Legal basis
- Regulated entities
- Fee structure
- Fee level
- Implementation arrangements
- Monitoring and compliance
- Revenue allocation

### Designing Cost Recovery Measures (2)

#### Enabling legislative steps

- Empowerment of Ministers to enact fees
- Allocation of responsibilities for hazard and risk assessment between public and private sectors
- Fees amount
- Renewal/ repeat intervals
- Terms for inspection and monitoring
- Provisions for "orphan" substances that require licensing
- Waiver of fees
- Fees for further laboratory analysis
- Use of revenues
- Empowerment of Minister to enact cost recovery regulations
- Date of commencement and length of validity
