A Metodologia de Avaliação Rápida do MSPglobal (MAR do MSPglobal) é baseada nos guias da UNESCO-COI sobre Planejamento Espacial Marinho (PEM) e foi projetada para apoiar e avançar os processos de PEM. Ela identifica atividades e tarefas que já foram realizadas, compreende as lacunas existentes e propõe ações para os países beneficiários apoiados pela UNESCO-COI, colaboradores e outras organizações que trabalham nesse campo.

Esta publicação destaca os resultados dos esforços para a implementação do Planejamento Espacial Marinho (PEM) no Brasil no âmbito da iniciativa MSPglobal. Foram identificadas iniciativas que respondem às crescentes pressões das atividades humanas e às mudanças climáticas, se unindo à estratégia mais ampla do Brasil para a governança integrada das zonas costeiras e marinhas. O documento também apresenta recomendações resultantes da avaliação das diferentes fases do PEM no país, incorporando contribuições de uma ampla gama de atores, incluindo instituições públicas, setor privado e sociedade civil.

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
