Pilot use-cases and partners

1. Accelerate decarbonisation

Achieve 100% SAF flights (mix of mass balance and book and claim SAF purchase)

2. Bridge limited supply locations Airline purchase of SAF without physical connection to supply

3. Corporate travel emission reduction

Corporate customers purchase of SAF to claim the environmental benefits (i.e. GHG reductions) to reduce their aviation-related emissions


Scope 1 claim: air carrier

The airline may allocate the Scope 3 emission reduction to its passengers, such as for example by including the reduction in its global passenger transportation emission figure or allocating it to individual passengers who purchase the reduction with their ticket. This is not tracked within the RSB Registry.

Retirement Statement

- ✓ Each BCU carries one Scope 1 claim and several Scope 3 claims, which shall be done according to the claiming, double counting and additionality requirements of this Manual
- ✓ Companies mentioned in the retirement statement are entitled to claims.
- ✓ The retirement statement is automatically published in a public retirement statement table available on the RSB Registry website
- ✓ Option for the name of Scope 3 buyer to be anonymised in the public table when contracts bound by confidentiality

Boston Consulting Group Steps Up Investment into Decarbonization through Sustainable Aviation Fuel Agreement with World Energy

- Five-year contract will deliver emissions reductions of 100,000 metric tons of CO₂—
 equivalent to flying 177,000 economy-class passengers round trip between Boston and London¹
- 100,000 metric tons of CO₂ would represent more than half of BCG's air travel CO₂ emissions in 2023
- This is BCG's largest SAF certificate purchase to date


Unlocking economic benefit through ambitious sustainability standards

- ✓ Funded by ISEAL Innovations Fund grant this initiative highlights **the economic benefits** of maintaining ambitious sustainability goals to enhance outcomes for the environment, society, and the smallholders practicing best practices.
- ✓ Sustainability must encompass more than climate change mitigation.
- ✓ Small-scale producers are essential for sustainability but face economic challenges. A **book and claim system** can incentivise them with additional revenue. The project will validate this model by testing the market's willingness to pay for additional **sustainability impacts** and enhancing data management.
- ✓ Smallholders are engaged to test **soil and water impact claim** generation, including data management and verification by digital solution providers, a pilot to test impact claim generation, transfer and claim, and finally the development of a livelihood impact indicator to measure the livelihood benefit of impact claims income.

The RSB Book & Claim System launched a registry in November 2023:

- Transfer and claim Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) emissions reductions
- 2 previous years of piloting & based on normative guidance developed on consultation with RSB's multistakeholder community
- Willingness to pay for increased emission savings and market demand is clearly demonstrated.
