Hungary has interconnections with all neighbouring countries except Slovenia


Hungary – 2 SSO's:



- 4 sites, unified storage system
- Only commercial stocks
- (Licence for strategic storage)
- Main flexibility provider
- Total of 4.43 bcm WG capacity
- Injection: 31.6 mcm/d
- Withdrawal: 53.6 mcm/d



- 1 site
- Strategic (1.45 bcm) and commercial stocks, physically not separated
- Total of 1.9 bcm WG capacity
- Injection: 12.7 mcm/d
- Withdrawal: 25 mcm/d



Total storage capacities


- 6.3 bcm WG capacity
- Injection: 44.3 mcm/d
- Withdrawal: 78.6 mcm/d



Storage booking trend is changing in Hungary



The yearly natural gas consumption has decreased in the last 10 years, however it stopped decreasing in 2016.



The storage booking level exceeded 100% in 2019 at Hungarian Gas Storage.



The most relevant stakeholders for SSOs in Hungary



Ministry








- Responsible for gas law
- Defines the location and measure of strategic stocks in Ministerial Decree
- Sets out the obligatory minimum injection and withdrawal capacity
- Determines the reason of use, measure, price, order of replenishment in case of emergency

- Issues the licenses for storage operators
- Set the tariff for SSOs
- Proposes the measure of strategic stocks to the Minister
- Responsible for the preparation of Emergency Plan and Preventive Action Plan



Security of supply tools







Since Hungary's import dependency is close to 85%, many SoS tools are applied



SoS policy in Hungary

Winter preparation plan

Supplier of USP (protected) customers obliged to secure supply and report supply plan to NRA **Obligatory** booking

Supplier of USP customers has to secure 60% of the winter consumption in underground gas storage (Max consumption of last 10 years).

Strategic storage

Defined amount of gas has to be kept in underground gas storage as a strategic reserve.

The purpose is to secure the supply in winter and in case of crisis situation as well.



Strategic and commercial storages are responsible for different parts of the supply

Only minister can relase the stock	Availability	Based on customer demand
Act on SoS and ministerial decree	Legislation	Act on gas supply

Not subject of tariff regulation	Price	Regulated tariff (price cap)
Hungarian Hydrocarbon Stockpiling Association	The owner of the injected gas	Customers of SSOs
Distort the competition without strong regulation	Effect on the market	Decrease gas price volatility
