I - carry their credential or license at a visible location; II - dress in a manner consistent with the location in which they will develop their activities, as per the criteria set out in specific normative acts; III - keep their personal and professional data up to date; IV - act with civility and discipline while carrying out their activities in accordance with the code of ethics of the profession; V - get to know and comply with the regulations of the Presidential Palace.
2. The use of the credential or license is personal and non-transferable, and its holder is liable for administrative, civil and criminal sanctions in case of misuse.
 The credential or license must be returned to the Department of Registration [Setor de Credenciamento] of the Presidency Press Secretariat [Secretaria de Imprensa da Presidência da República] (SIMP) in case of cancellation, suspension or revocation of said accreditation or license.
 In case of loss or misplacement of the credential or license, the professional must immediately report the fact to the Department of Registration of the Press Secretariat, in writing and accompanied by the relevant police report.
5. Pursuant to Normative Standard X-409, access to media professionals must be free, effected exclusively through the lobby of the Presidential Palace and the premises of the SIMP. Media professionals may access annex buildings for use of the building's restaurant, banking, news-stand and post office services. In other areas, press professionals may only circulate when properly accompanied by a SIMP staff member.
